for riders with physical impairment

All athletes are classified according to their physical impairement.









Paralympics every 4 years.

- Para Dressage (Paralympics)-5 Grades (I, II, IV, V)
- Para Driving (World Championships)-2 Grades (I, II)

If a rider has a physical impairement that can be classified, can start under FEI even if he/she also has an intellectual impairment.





Virtus is the global organisation that *governs – advocates – organises – promotes* elite sport for athletes with an intellectual impairment.

Global Games are held every 4 years.

Para Dressage – 3 groups:

II-1: Athletes with intellectual impairment, IQ under 75, significant limitation in adaptive behavior, diagnosed before the age of 22

II-2: Athletes with intellectual impairement and significant additional impairment like Down Syndrome

II-3: Athletes with Autism (IQ 75 and over)







for riders with intellectual impairment who also can have physical impairment

World Games every 4 years







Requirements similar to Virtus II-1, but IQ below 70

Divisioning (Divisions should consist of 3-8 riders)

Step 1: Rider Profile Form filled in by the SO Coach

Step 2: Preliminary Test (English Equitation) to separate riders into proper ability divisions.

Philosophy	Sport for all, everybody should get a chance	Elite Sport High Performance (Using FEI Tests)
Divisions	Athletes ride according to their ability.	Athletes have to be able to ride the test that are requested in their eligibility groups (II-1, II-2, II-3)
Competitions	Organized by National and International SO	Organized by or under Virtus or sanctioned by Virtus
Disciplines	Different disciplines to choose from (Dressage, Jumping, Gymkhanaincluding team relays)	Dressage Team Competition and Individual Competition
Qualification	Nations can choose the riders according to their own policies	Riders have to achieve a minimum of 58% twice in a video competition riding the Performance Tests in order to join the international live competitions
Horses	At World Games riders are competing on borrowed horses	On international level riders can bring their own horses, but borrowed horses are provided. Riders on own horses get a score deduction for fairness.
Equipment	Auxiliary reins allowed	No auxiliary reins
Restrictions	Riders can join the SO Summer Games (World Games) only twice (everybody should get a chance to join once)	No limits regarding participation, except of their own performance


